Welcome to the Opening Day festivities at the Pine Ridge athletic field complex. The development of this complex has been a unique cooperative venture, combining the efforts and resources of the Fairfax Women's Soccer Association (FWSA), the Annandale National Little League (ANLL), the Northern Virginia Soccer League (NVSL), the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, the Fairfax County Park Authority Board, the Fairfax County Park Authority, the Fairfax County Department of Public Works, the Fairfax County Department of Recreation and Community Services, the U.S. Naval Reserve 23rd Mobile Construction Battalion (the famed Seabees), and local businesses.

In 1980, an interim use agreement gave 36 acres of the unused Pine Ridge High School site to the Fairfax County Park Authority for development into recreational facilities. No funds were designated for the project, so three non-profit organizations (FWSA, ANLL, and NVSL) joined forces and formed the Pine Ridge Association for Little League and Soccer (PALS) to coordinate the development of three Little League and three soccer fields at the site. When it was decided that the entranceway then in use was unsafe for the traffic anticipated with team sports activities, PALS was in danger of losing the potential for developing the site, but the Fairfax County Park Authority stepped in at that time to provide a safe entranceway, making it possible for development of the site to proceed. PALS enlisted the support of the Seabees in grading the site and arranged for additional donations of services and equipment from local businesses. With raffles and various fundraising activities, PALS raised some \$50,000 for the project and also arranged for the donation of approximately \$300,000 worth of in-kind services. In addition, members of PALS have donated many hours of personal manual labor to the project. Despite this effort it appeared that drought, vandalism and poor drainage might spell the demise of the project until the County agencies stepped in with more help. Now with fencing, an irrigation system and an improved parking lot, the Pine Ridge site offers some of the finest ballfields in the County.

Elsewhere in this program we pay tribute to all the organizations, agencies, businesses and individuals who provided support for this project. Through working together and maintaining a positive attitude we have achieved our goal, and we are very proud of this accomplishment. Thank you for joining us in our celebration of the new Pine Ridge Fields.
